



INBOUND YEP STUDENT INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

Part A. Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC)

To obtain a visa, the Australian Government requires Students visiting Australia to provide evidence of Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC), which is available online from various approved Insurers covering basic Medical & Hospital expenses. Period of insurance must be the same as the period on their visa.

(Students from Norway, Sweden and Belgium may be exempt due to reciprocal agreements with the Australian Government)

Part B. Travel Insurance

Inbound students must provide evidence of travel insurance (in addition to OSHC) in accordance with Rotary Code of Policies 41.060.10, with the following **minimum** amounts:

• Overseas Hospital/Medical/Dental Expenses	US\$1,000,000
• Accidental Death	100,000
• Capital Benefits	100,000
• Emergency Evacuation	50,000
• Repatriation of student's remains in the event of	50,000
• Political/natural disaster evacuation	50,000
• Legal Liability	500,000

Limits less than the above are not acceptable, and a Certificate of Currency or other evidence of insurance from a reputable Insurer is to be provided and accepted by the Australian Host District prior to the Student's departure.

Part C. Australian Inbound Travel Insurance (Chubb Insurance Policy 04PP005604)

In the event that compliant Travel Insurance is not available from the Student's home country, Inbound Students may procure Australian Inbound YEP Insurance. 2017 premium: **AUS\$575**

Please Note: All medical claims are to be lodged with the OSHC insurer prior to claiming from the Travel Policy
